## SOUTHERN CENTER FOR HUMAN RIGHTS HONORS ATTORNEYS PROTECTING THE RIGHTS OF GUANTANAMO DETAINEES

NY Times Columnist Bob Herbert to Keynote November 1 Dinner

The Southern Center for Human Rights will present the *Frederick Douglass Human Rights Award* to the lawyers at firms, public interest organizations, and in the military who are protecting the fundamental rights of so-called "enemy combatants" detained at Guantánamo Bay. The Awards Dinner, to be held at the J.W. Marriott Hotel in Washington, D.C., will take place on November 1, 2007 at 6 p.m. Shayana Kadidal of The Center for Constitutional Rights, Thomas B. Wilner with the law firm Shearman & Sterling LLP, and Major Michael D. Mori will accept the award on behalf of the honorees. Bob Herbert, Op-ed Columnist at The New York Times, will deliver the keynote address.
